Deadline & Expectations for NUSTEP Ontario Students

OVERVIEW DOCUMENT

All eligible students will register for their coursework by visiting the NUSTEP Ontario website at www.niagara.edu/nustep-ontario/ after the registration window opens. Only high school juniors and seniors are eligible to participate in the NUSTEP program.

Once the Registration Period (09/24/24 - 10/11/24) has ended, students will be able to pay for their course work. Detailed instructions for setting up a Purple Pass account and paying for these courses is available on the website. Students will have from 10/21/24 to 11/13/24 to pay for their courses. The cost of NUSTEP courses is \$140 CAD per credit hour (\$420 for a 3 credit/\$560 for a 4 credit course). Students will make their payment online via [Touchnet-Canada](http://Touchnet-Canada.com).

Refunds are only available for the tuition paid during the billing/payment period (10/21/24 - 11/13/24). Absolutely no refunds will be issued after 11/13/24.

IMPORTANT DATES AND DEADLINES

Tuesday, September 24, 2024	NUSTEP Registration portal opens - Students may register for courses online
Friday, October 11, 2024	NUSTEP Registration portal closes - No registrations accepted after this point
Monday, October 21, 2024	Students establish their PurplePass accounts, log-in and pay their bill on-line
Wednesday, November 13, 2024	PAYMENT DEADLINE: ALL COURSES MUST BE PAID IN FULL BY 5PM
Thursday, November 14, 2024	ROSTER VERIFICATION DAY: All unpaid students will be deregistered from courses Any course dropped after this date will not be refunded. Students will receive a "W" for courses dropped from 11/14 until 12/1
Sunday, December 1, 2024	Last day to drop a course and receive a "W"; no refund issued.
Monday, December 2, 2024	Any course dropped hereafter will receive a grade of "U". <i>*This grade is not transferable and does/should not impact a student's future GPA</i>

Late Drop/Withdrawal Process

At any point on or after 11/14/24, students may withdraw from the class by sending an email to Niagara's registrar Harry Gong, hgong@niagara.edu indicating the course that they are dropping. A grade of W will be assigned until December 1st after which a grade of U will be assigned in April.
